Identity theft strikes 1 in 50 people every year in the United States. Strategies to minimize the losses associated with identity theft is to document all personal identity information, update as needed, secure in a safe location, and do not allow unauthorized individuals access to your information.

- Personal identity information includes the following items:
- Name, birth date, social security number, drivers license number, current address, phone numbers, and email addresses
- Insurance information
- Credit/debit cards names, account numbers, and expiration dates
- Bank and financial institutions, names, and account numbers
- All other account numbers, i.e. utilities, phone, and cable etc.
